The College offers several spaces for students to exhibit their work:

Redwood Campus (RWC)

- *The Annex Gallery* is adjacent to the Wiseman Gallery on the RWC (the Annex). The gallery was developed with funding assistance from the ASRCC.
- The Student Center features work from the Art Club on the RWC.
- Community exhibits from the Esther Bristol Education Center occasionally offers students an exhibit opportunity.
- The halls of the Art Department have bulletin boards for student classwork.

Riverside Campus (RVC)

- *The other Gallery* is on the Mezzanine level of G Building on the RVC.
- B Building Halls offer students a chance to have work displayed.
- The annual student exhibit occurs in the G Building Lobby.
- *Other sites on all campuses as developed.*

These spaces are primarily for RCC students to exhibit their work. These exhibit areas are unique and offer students an opportunity to learn the mechanics of preparing for an exhibit as well as installation and promotion. Non-art students may also exhibit with specific approval.

Application Process:

A member of the art faculty and the gallery curator will review the actual artwork proposed for exhibit unless the exhibit is class work only. The pieces will be judged on the following criteria: 1) artistic achievement, 2) originality, and 3) community interest.
