These groups are established as needed and appropriate, with the executive team engaging in a regular review of these groups and their functions to ensure broad, fair, and equitable engagement with the Rogue Community College decision-making process. The executive team meets regularly to discuss matters related to college operations and serves in an advisory capacity to the College President.

## Community Input

RCC engages community members in an advisory capacity regarding institutional planning, campus safety, program and curriculum development, and budget preparation as required. At the president's discretion, community members may be invited to serve on other advisory committees.
