Policy 010: Online Learning Accessibility

8.E.010: RCC is determined to provide an accessible and engaged experience to all students, whether at a physical location or online. The College commits that all online offerings will comply with applicable federal and state laws and regulations, and will function consistently with the World Wide Web Consortium's internationally accepted Web Content Accessibility Guidelines 2.0.

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Policy 020: Credit Hour Policy

VIII.E.020: The definition of a credit hour at Rogue Community College shall be in agreement with that of the federal government as stated in 34 CFR §600.2, restated below:

A credit hour is an amount of work represented in intended learning outcomes and verified by evidence of student achievement that is an institutionally established equivalency that reasonably approximates:

1. Not less than one hour of classroom or direct faculty instruction and a minimum of two hours out of class student work each week for approximately ten to twelve weeks for one quarter hour of credit, or the equivalent amount of work over a different amount of time, or
2. At least an equivalent amount of work as required outlined in item (1) above for other academic activities as established by the institution including laboratory work, internships, practica, studio work, and other academic work leading to the award of credit hours.

The College has procedures for award of credit consistent with federal, state and accreditation guidelines and rules.
