- ~~2. Provide materials that will stimulate growth in factual knowledge, literary appreciation, aesthetic values, and ethical standards;~~
- ~~3. Provide materials on opposing sides of controversial issues so that citizens may develop, under guidance, the practice of critical thinking and reading;~~
- ~~4. Provide materials representative of the many religious, ethnic, and cultural groups and their contributions to our American heritage;~~
- ~~5. Place principle above personal opinion and reason above prejudice in the selection of materials in the highest quality of order to assure a comprehensive collection appropriate for the users of the College Library.~~
