If your access to financial aid has been denied due to lack of academic progress, you may enroll and pay for your tuition, fees, and books yourself, while you work to regain access to financial aid. Or, you may submit this appeal to Rogue Central Services if you believe you qualify.

Qualifying Extenuating Circumstances

My future access to financial aid was suspended as a result of extenuating circumstances that meet the following criteria:

- Unforeseen (not pre-existing prior to drop deadline, second Wednesday of the term)
- Occurred after the drop period and before the end of the term
- Beyond my control
- Directly impacted my ability to successfully complete the term
- Documentable (provide signed statement demonstrating the above, with letter/receipts from doctor, employer, attorney, landlord, obituary, etc.)

Instructions: Submit a signed statement, clearly describing the facts and timing of your extenuating circumstances. Also, explain what you have done to resolve them so that they will not get in the way of your future success. Submit documentation to support your statements.

Qualifying Exception to Aid Suspension

My future access to financial aid was suspended. My last term at RCC was at least five years ago and my term credit completion during my last term on aid does not meet minimum requirements and/or I have a cGPA of less than 2.0. This does not apply if your net attempted credits are equal to at least half your program length and your pace is below 66.67%.

Academic Plan (AP) Criteria Met

My access to financial aid was suspended and I was on Probation by Appeal or I was on an Academic Plan, and I enrolled only in necessary courses and successfully completed ALL my attempted credits with A, B, C, or P grades, but still need to work to meet cGPA requirements. Therefore, I believe I qualify for access to future financial aid under an Academic Plan.
