



Verification Instructions 2020/21

Verification is the process of checking information that you reported on your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). The Department of Education selects students for verification. Selection does not mean that you reported information incorrectly. Selection means that schools have to collect documentation to confirm or correct information on your application.

Please provide your verification documentation as soon as possible. The deadline to complete verification is either 120 days from the last day of term (if you stop attending RCC after Summer or Fall term) or 6/11/21 (if you attend Winter or Spring term at RCC). If you do not complete verification by the deadline, we cannot process your application or award financial aid.

During the verification process, we may ask you for additional information. We may ask for documents to verify unclear or conflicting information. Please check your myRogue account to see the documents we need from you. If any changes to your FAFSA are necessary, we will make the correction and you will receive a revised Student Aid Report (SAR).

What You Need to Do:

- Go to www.roguecc.edu
- Log into myRogue
- Click on Financial Aid Status and “What I Must Do to Complete My Application / My Messages”
- Submit the requested forms and documentation
